- We are accepting applications for enrollment for grades 6 and 9. A lottery will be conducted if more applications are submitted than seats available.
- Applicants must be a resident of Michigan and eligible to enter the grade for which they are applying at the start of the 2010-2011 school year.
- To be eligible for admission, complete applications must be postmarked by Monday, February 8, 2010 or hand delivered no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 10, 2010.
- Applications received after the deadline will be added to the waitlist.
- Students interested in enrolling in grades 7, 8, and 10 will be placed on an existing waitlist in the order received and admitted as seats become available.
- Each sibling interested in enrolling for the 2010-2011 school year **MUST** complete and submit his/her own application for enrollment. Siblings who fail to have an application on file by the end of open enrollment will not receive any priority for admission.
